Guardian Counts – Circuit / County

The numbers on this report may appear inconsistent because the total count of guardians in a circuit is not simply the sum of guardians in each county. This discrepancy occurs because guardians may serve in multiple counties within the circuit. For example, if a circuit has 10 guardians and they can serve in all three counties, the circuit total remains 10, but each county's count would also be 10, resulting in an apparent county total of 30.
